COMING INTO PRESENCE God is already present in the body. When I am present in the body I am present to God

'When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" ³⁹ He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day.' John 1: 38-39

The very first words uttered by Jesus in John's gospel here: 'What are you looking for' Better translated *what are you seeking*? (Greek *zetien* 34 times) The response of the two 'unnamed' disciples are another question...Where are you 'staying'? (Greek *menein 40 Times*) often translated *abide*, or *remain*. Where are you *abiding*? Where is your heart rooted....we notice something and cannot help following.

'Come and see'

Key words: 'seeking, abiding, seeing'

There is a mystery to who God/Jesus is...There is mystery to what this world is....and there is mystery to who we are...

This mystery surrounds these *Relationships....* Creator Creation Creature

There is a path into this mystery here a path of seeking, abiding and seeing Making connections in these relationships. With Mystery there is always more.

Sacred Matter

Intro Brief FILM TEILHARD VISIONARY SCIENTIST

A Jesuit priest_who was also a renowned Scientist (Palaeontologist) and mystic,He brings a synthesis with Science and Faith. He died in1955 without any of his writings being published. His beloved order and the Church have come 180 degrees since his death. ...and relevant to this exploration today as Teilhard brings together a love of God and a healthy love of the world.

'There is communion with God, There is communion with Earth, There is Communion with God Through Earth'

His seeking included attention to the smallest details of the physical world such as stones fossils and nature radically opened him to God.[] Learning to see is paying attention to detail, paying attention with all my faculties

The stuff of the Universe for Pierre Teilhard is *Spirit-Matter*. 'Matter is the matrix of Spirit. Spirit is the higher form of matter.' Teilhard's efforts were to help us discover Christ in the heart of matter.

'It is God and God alone whom the Christian pursues through the reality of created things. For him or her, interest lies truly **in** things, but in absolute dependence upon God's presence in them'¹

A PLACE IN NATURE WHERE YOU EXPERIENCE GOD'S PRESENCE (1 minute each)

'Seeing. One could say that the whole of life lies in seeing —2

Learning to see is 'being Contemplative.'

Walter Burghardt s.j. described Contemplation as; 'take a long, loving look at the real.'3

SD's are contemplatives. The practice of Spiritual Direction is contemplation. Spiritual Directors are *the new contemplatives*.

Contemplatives create an open space *to see*. There was a time when the contemplative was called a *SEER*. Learning to see goes hand in hand with contemplative practice. There is always more

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Seeing is the fruit of grace of 'letting go' to discover the divine at the heart of Matter.

'by virtue of the Creation and, still more, of the Incarnation, nothing here below is profane for those who know how to see'.⁴

At the very beginning of the SE of St Ignatius the directee is invited to consider how God sees me...and we are invited to see back. 'I look and God and God looks at me'. There is a seeing both ways. [26]

EXERCISE BEING PRESENT STONES

Birdlings Flat which borders Lake Elsmere and Lake Forsyth

Waikirikri (gravelly stream) Waimakariri (cold river)

'Everything is sacred' Pelagius the first significant Celtic teacher) taught that Grace is given to reconnect us to our nature, which is Sacred and made of God.

A dominant Christian view on the other hand was that *grace is given to save us from our nature.* We still meet this in our SD practice.....a separation from our true identity as sacred and of God

What was Teilhard seeing that he wanted to share with us?

Throughout my life, by means of my life, the world has little by little caught fire in my sight, until a flame all around me, it has become almost luminous from within. Such has been my experience in contact with the Earth. The diaphany of the divine at the heart of the universe on fire.....CHRIST; His heart; a fire gradually spreading everywhere.

Jesus knew his connectedness with **creation creature and creation**. Identity in Johns gospel as 'I AM' THE SD for Ignatius '**allows the creator to deal directly with the creature'**

In italics under the introduction to the *DIVINE MILLIEU* (which is an essay on the interior life) There are three latin words *In eo vivimus* from acts 17:28 in him we live or 'IN CHRIST WE LIVE' everything in this text must be understood with this backdrop according to Louis Savary. IN CHRIST WE LIVE Where are you staying? Where are you abiding....come and see....... *I abide everywhere*

As we pay attention to the finest detail or this sacred earth we can observe everything in the Universe as dynamic and moving toward greater consciousness and greater union.

STONES from Birdlings flat bordering Lake Forsyth and Lake Elsmere are degraded and still suffering

. BIRD ON WEST This is a mātuku hūrepo an Australasian bittern now endangered - very few breeding pairs left in Waitaha Canterbury

Many of Canterbury's lowland waterways are already degraded, commonly by pollution allowed from large areas of intensive farming. This is the predicament of many lowland rivers. This week, the Government weakened key provisions of the Resource Management Act, meaning more pollution into rivers, lakes, wetlands and estuaries nationwide - such as nitrate from cow urine - is suddenly allowable. This Is a disaster for our unique aquatic ecosystems and for efforts to make them healthy enough for our tamariki to enjoy once again. These law changes have been rushed through, without any public input or scrutiny. ⁸
